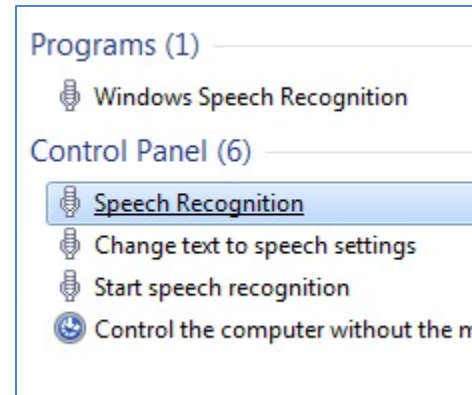
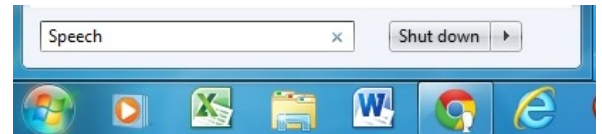


# NativeAccent Quick Start

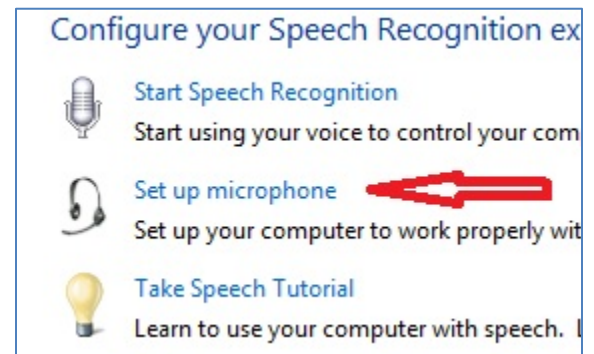
## Setting up and Adjusting the Microphone

Before you can begin using NativeAccent, you will need to first set up the microphone for Speech Recognition in Windows 7.

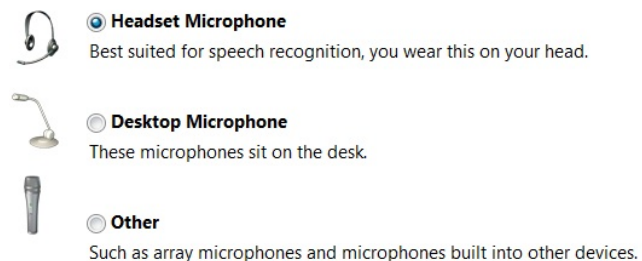
1. First click on the Windows 7 Start button and type "speech" in the search programs box.
2. A list of items featuring "speech" will be displayed including the **Speech Recognition** control panel. Click on the **Speech Recognition control panel**.



3. Select the "Microphone Setup" option in the Speech Recognition Control Panel



- This will open the **Microphone Setup Wizard**.
  - If you have a headset microphone select "**Headset Microphone**"
  - If you are using the built-in microphone (not recommended) on your laptop computer, select "**Other**"



4. Follow the steps in the wizard to complete the microphone setup for speech recognition by ensuring proper microphone placement and reading the provided sentence in a normal speaking voice. If there are errors (Too Loud or Too Soft or Too Noisy), the wizard will make suggestions on ways to correct these errors.

*Once you have successfully completed the wizard you are ready to begin using NativeAccent.*
